



### Quick Start Guide

How to install RemoMail and set up your email accounts



#### Overview:

RemoMail is the latest product offering from Remoba and it is just been released. RemoMail is an Email application which can be used with mobile phones. RemoMail connects to your personal and business email accounts. Using RemoMail you can perform all functions of an email such as viewing, composing, deleting, replying, and sending email messages.

#### Purchasing:

RemoMail is easy and very easy to setup. Navigate to Remoba Application Portal zone. Select RemoMail to download the application. Once you have purchased RemoMail, a RemoMail icon will be displayed in the Applications/Games folder on your mobile Phone.

#### Features:

RemoMail supports POP/IMAP servers, webaccess to MS Exchange and Lotus Notes.

RemoMail also supports to connect to your personal providers such as Yahoo, Hotmail, Gmail, and so on.

RemoMail is much secured. RemoMail has an option for SSL configuration.

RemoMail supports **Group** features to quickly add recipients from predefined groups.

A powerful search feature to search for mails by sender, by date or subject

#### Configuring your Accounts:

Using RemoMail, you can access your email from any popular email service provider. Enter your user id password and select Done in the Options Left Soft Key.

*Note: For configuring corporate account you need to select the server version —*

*MS Exchange or Lotus Notes, enter the URL address, user name, and password. Your new Corporate Account is created.*

*Note: Quick Message option is also available in the Subject filed while composing a mail.*

#### Setting POP/IMAP Access:

Select Other POP/other IMAP option.

Enter your User ID, Password.

Enable SSL configuration (depending on your POP/IMAP server) following the procedures.

By default the Port no is displayed.

Once you enter all the details Press Done to complete the account configuration.

#### Main Menu Options:

The Main Menu screen is preceded by the Launch screen. By selecting on any configured account you can fetch mails.

The Main Menu screen has the option to Get Mail, Compose Mail, Drafts, Account Setup, Outbox, Quick Message, Help and Exit.

*Note: If the account is an IMAP account then the Get Folders option is available which will allow you to access server folders*

**Quick Message** is a handy feature helps you to quickly use some predefined messages and add them to the mail that you want to send saving valuable time.

The Read Mail screen has the options to do a Reply, Reply All, Forward, Save Info, Mark to Delete.

*Note: Save Info option is a special feature which allows you to save the sender's mail Id to the phone's address book as a new contact or append it to an existing contact.*

#### Setting the Pagesize Setup

RemoMail also has the feature to setup page size for the number of headers displayed per page on your phone. You can set your page upto a minimum of 3 mails and a max of 10 mails per page.

**Groups:** Groups can be created which enable you to send email notifications to the group instead of individual contacts. You can create a maximum of 10 groups.

#### Poison Pill:

Poison Pill is a security feature that can be used to delete all private information stored on your phone like the email account information, contact information etc. This prevents unauthorized use of RemoMail. All you have to do is enter your phone number and click on 'Send' from the web page. To issue a Poison Pill, access your account at [www.remoba.com](http://www.remoba.com)
