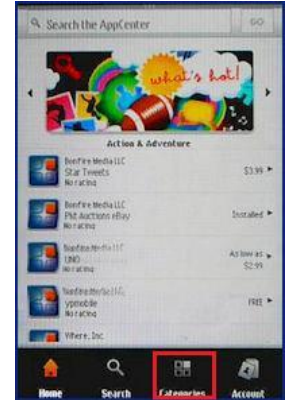
Downloading RemoSync



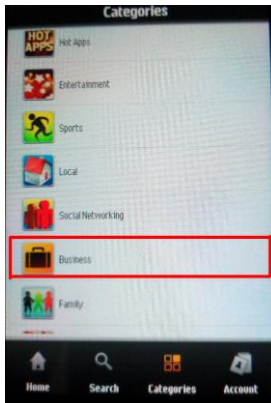
1. Select the Main Menu.



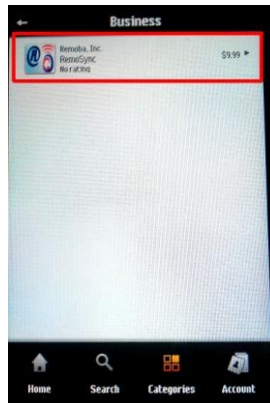
2. Select AppCenter.



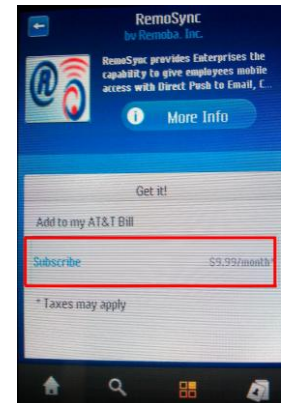
3. Select Categories.



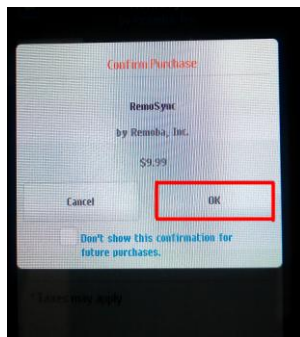
4. Select Business.



5. Select RemoSync.



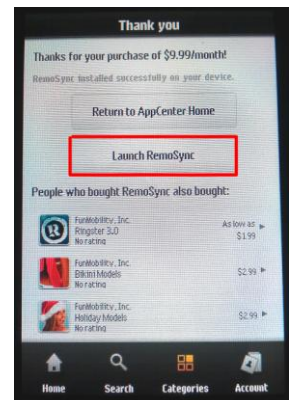
6. Select Subscribe

*1. Select "IBM Lotus Notes" from the provider list then select "Next."



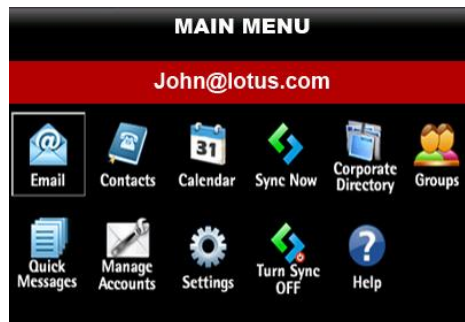
2. Enter your username, password, domain, then select "Next."

1. Select "Other Professional Email Accounts" then select "Next."



2. Now enter your username, password, and email address then select "Next."



3. If your email provider is not common, the application will prompt you to enter the incoming server address then select "Next."



4. Next, create a PIN number then select "Next."



5. Once the sync process finishes, the application will take you to the main menu.
