About This Manual

This manual covers iPhonebook use on mobile phones.

The manual shows how to:

- Get Started with the iPhonebook Service
- Use of iPhonebook on the mobile phone
- Use of iPhonebook's Web Account

The manual assumes you are familiar with basic menu navigation for your particular mobile phone and with using mobile phone keys to enter text.

iPhonebook Overview

iPhonebook is a mobile phone data service that wirelessly connects you to your address book. The application enables you to search for contact information, select a phone number and connect the call. iPhonebook also lets you select contacts from your desktop (or iPhonebook Web Account) to download to the phone's native address book.

When you register for iPhonebook service, an online address book is created (your iPhonebook Web Account). your iPhonebook Web Account will be empty. You will populate your iPhonebook Web Account by synchronizing your existing PIM contacts (typically Microsoft Outlook®, Microsoft Outlook Express®, Lotus Notes® or Palm™ software). Alternatively, you may choose to manually enter contact data into your iPhonebook Web Account or import your contacts.

If you have not already registered for iPhonebook, please do so at www.remoba.com. By registering you receive the synchronization software that enables you to synchronize your existing contacts and access them through your mobile phone and your iPhonebook Web Account.

Getting Started

There are three easy steps to get started with the iPhonebook service:

1. Purchase iPhonebook using your mobile phone
2. Register your iPhonebook service
3. Populate iPhonebook with your existing contacts

Each step will be described in this section. Steps 2 and 3 require access to your PC and Internet connection.

Step 1 – Purchase iPhonebook

Using your mobile phone, navigate to the application download area. Then select the shopping cart icon. Select the category that best relates to business tools. Select iPhonebook.

When you select iPhonebook and confirm your desire to purchase it, an iPhonebook icon will appear on your application download menu.

iPhonebook is now on your mobile phone, however, it is empty. iPhonebook's Main Menu has a "Get Started Here" option directing you to a URL for registration. This is covered in Step 2.

Step 2 – Register your iPhonebook Service

If you have not already done so, you need to register your iPhonebook service.

During the registration process, you will accomplish these things:

- Create a username, password and PIN
- Download and install the Synchronization software

Note: The Synchronization software synchronizes your existing contacts to iPhonebook. It is the recommended way to begin using iPhonebook immediately. iPhonebook does provide two other options to get your contacts into iPhonebook: Import and Manual Entry. These two other ways will be discussed later.

Getting Started, continued

Click on the "Register" button.

You will be prompted to enter your first name, last name, email address, and mobile phone number. Be sure to enter the mobile phone number that has the iPhonebook service. You will also be prompted to create a username, password and PIN (Personal Identification Number) and a hint in case you forget your password. See the Help section on more information about Forgotten Password.

When you are finished entering the information, select the **Go to Next Step** button to display the next page and to download the synchronization software.

Synchronization will "copy" your existing contacts in your desktop PIM (Microsoft Outlook, Outlook Express or Palm) into iPhonebook. Thereafter, you can use the Sync desktop icon to perform a sync whenever you wish to update iPhonebook with the contacts that are in your desktop PIM.

Alternatively, if you do not wish to install the synchronization software, you can do an Import, where you create a .csv file and import it into iPhonebook. Everytime you wish iPhonebook to have the same contacts as your desktop PIM, you will have to create a .csv file and import it into iPhonebook. More information about Import can be found in the Help section of this manual.

Finally, you can always manually enter your contacts into iPhonebook. See the iPhonebook Web PIM section of this manual.

Select the **Download Now** link to download and install the Synchronization software. This process will create an icon on your desktop.

Use this icon whenever you wish to sync your desktop PIM with iPhonebook. Your contacts are now in iPhonebook!

More information about synchronization can be found in the Help section of this manual.

Login

Highlight and select **Login** from the iPhonebook Menu.

The display is as shown in Figure 3a. Enter your Mobile Access Phone Number used during registration. **Select** to continue.

Enter your Mobile Access PIN chosen during registration. **Select** to continue. See Figure 3b.

Upon successful login, the display will show the Main Menu. See Figure 4.

From the Main Menu you can highlight and select:

Search Contacts, continue to page 5
Settings, continue to page 7
Help, continue to page 7

Exit iPhonebook – exits the application and returns you to the iPhonebook Login display.

Note: *Once you have successfully logged in, subsequent entry into iPhonebook does not require login.*

If an invalid phone number and PIN is entered, a Login Failed message appears. **Select** to re-Login.

Search Contacts

From the iPhonebook Main Menu, highlight and select **Search Contacts**. The *Search Contacts* display is shown. See Figure 5.

A search can be done by Last Name, First Name, and/or Company. Only one of these fields needs to be populated to receive search results. The more fields used however, the more narrow and precise the search results.

Example:

Entering "L" as the only Last Name search criteria, may return results for:

Lachtanski, Christina
Lachtanski, Karen
Lachtanski, Michael
Lane, Harry
Larson, Steve

However, entering "L" as the Last Name and "C" as the First Name search criteria returns only:

Lachtanski, Christina

Searching Contacts

The *Search Contact* display shows three available fields. To search for a contact, enter at least one character (alpha/numeric) in any of the three fields (Last Name, First Name, Company). The first field highlighted is Last Name.

Use the up/down button to move from field to field. Highlight and select **Go!** at any time when you wish to start the search. **Go!** is automatically highlighted after a character is entered in any of the fields.

Once a field is selected and search criteria entered, **Select** to submit the information. The **Search Contact** display is returned where you can either select another field to narrow the search, or select **Go!** to start the search.

You may also decide to search for a different contact by selecting *New Search*.

Using the example above, Last Name was highlighted and selected. "L" was entered as the criteria for Last Name. No other fields were entered. See Figure 6.

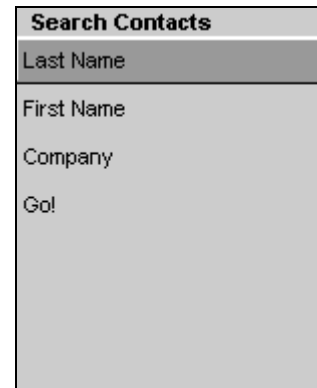

Search Contacts

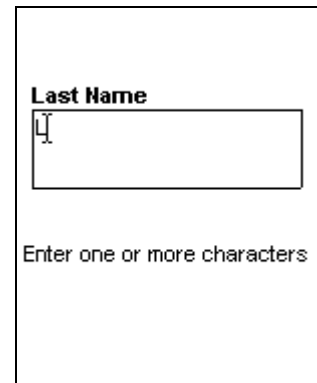

Search Continued

Upon selecting **Go!**, the Search Results screen appears after a few moments. Using our example, the first ten contacts that meet the search criteria for Last Name "L" are displayed in alphabetical (Last Name, First Name, Company) order. See Figure 7.

If the desired contact is not in the ten listed, the search needs to be narrowed by entering more specific search criteria.

If only one contact is found, the phone numbers for the contact are immediately displayed. If no contacts are found, a message is displayed: "Search Results are empty; try again." **Select** to return to Search Contacts screen.

Select / Browse a Contact

From the *Search Results* display, highlight and select the desired contact.

The display will show the contact's name (Last Name, First Name) and all the available phone numbers for the contact. Only the fields that have content will be displayed. See Figure 8.

The possible phone numbers for a contact are (in order of display):

- M: Mobile phone number
- B: Business number
- H: Home number
- F: Fax number

You can highlight and select any number to get connected. Continue to page 7.

You may highlight and select *Details...* to browse through other contact information about this particular contact. The following fields will be displayed if content is available: See Figure 9.

- Address (street address, city, state, country, zip code)
- Company Name
- Email address
- Notes field (the first 99 characters of the Notes field)

Select to return to previous screen.

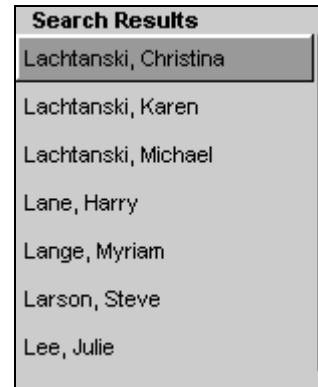

Search results

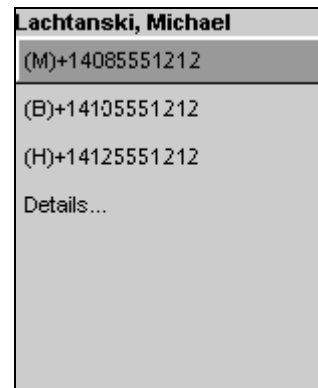

Make the Call

Once a contact's phone numbers are displayed, highlight and **Select** the desired phone number (mobile, business, home, or fax). You may also use the Green Call button instead of the Select function.

Change Settings

There may be times when you wish to let a friend or colleague use your phone to access their iPhonebook. This is possible by changing the settings.

From the Main Menu, highlight and select **Settings**. Select **Change Phone/PIN**. See Figure 12.

Enter the Mobile Access Phone Number used during registration. **Select** to continue.

Enter the Mobile Access PIN chosen during registration. **Select** to continue.

Upon successful settings change, the display will show the Main Menu.

Note: to access your iPhonebook after changing settings for a friend requires you to change settings back to your own phone number and PIN. Select **Change Phone/PIN** to enter your own information.

Exit iPhonebook

Exit the application from the iPhonebook Login Menu or from the Main Menu. Highlight and **Select** Exit iPhonebook.

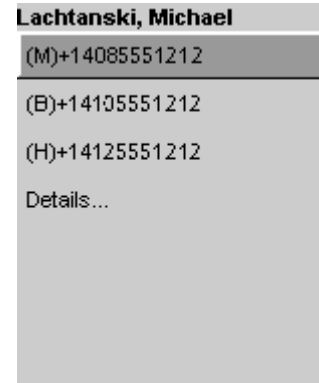

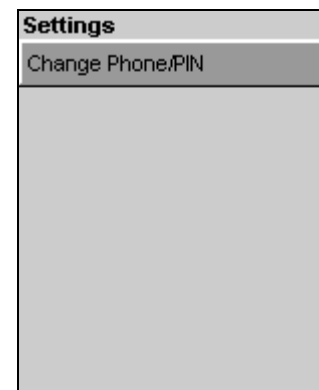

Help

Forgotten Password

During registration, you created several unique identifiers that are used to ensure the security and privacy of your data. These include: a password, a PIN, your mobile phone number and your email address. The mobile phone number and PIN are used to access iPhonebook on the mobile phone and these can be changed at any time using the Account Tab in your iPhonebook Web Account.

The email address and password are used to login to your iPhonebook Web Account. You can change your password at any time also using the Account Tab.

Recall that during registration you were asked to select one of three “hint questions” and the answer to the hint question. If you have forgotten your password, use the “Forgot Your Password?” link on the login page your iPhonebook Web Account. (If you did not bookmark this page, go to <http://www.remoba.com> and then click on the Login button. This will take you to your iPhonebook Web Account login page.) Your hint answer will be emailed to you.

Synchronization

When you install the iPhonebook Synchronization Software, a Sync icon is placed on your PC desktop. Double click on the icon or use the right mouse button to open the window. Each button is explained below.

Important Warning: In some cases, the synchronization process will truncate data. This occurs only if the data in your desktop PIM fields is longer than the allowable fields in iPhonebook. iPhonebook typically allows the same field lengths as most popular desktop PIMs; however, in some cases, iPhonebook’s fields may be shorter. If this occurs, an alert will be displayed. As a result, the truncated data will not be available through your iPhonebook Web Account or through iPhonebook’s mobile phone application. Additionally, if you make changes on the affected record in your iPhonebook Web Account and then use the synchronization feature, any truncated fields will be synchronized back to your desktop PIM.

Setup Wizard. The configuration process is done while you installed the software to define your username, password and the Desktop PIM you will synchronize to iPhonebook. Use the Wizard in the future to change any settings such as whether you now use a different Desktop PIM. *If you change your password using the Account tab in your iPhonebook Web Account, you must also use the Setup Wizard to change it in the synchronization software.*

Synchronize. Starts the synchronization process with your Desktop PIM. Use this as often as you like to make sure the contacts in your Desktop PIM is the same as the contacts your mobile phone will access.

Help. Launches the Help file where you can find additional information on the Setup Wizard and the Synchronization settings.

Exit. Closes the Synchronization software window.

If you decide to terminate your iPhonebook account, you should uninstall the Synchronization software. You can do this by using your PC’s uninstall procedure or by choosing File/Uninstall iPhonebook from the iPhonebook Synchronization Window menu.

Additional Support

On the Mobile Phone

On screen, context sensitive help is available at any time by pressing the asterisk "*" key.

On your iPhonebook Web Account

A Help link is available in the upper right corner of the browser window. Full details of your iPhonebook Web Account are available by page context sensitive or by overall functions and features.
